NETSTREAMS ANNOUNCES UPGRADES TO DIGILINX IP-BASED AUDIO

DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

ANAHEIM, Calif., Nov 9, 2005 – *NetStreams*[®], the global leader in networked entertainment systems based on Internet protocol (IP) technology, today announced firmware upgrades to the company's *DigiLinX*[™] IP-Based audio distribution system. Enhancements include improved on-screen controls for DVD players and XM[®] radio receivers as well as new on-screen controls for the Lutron[®] Homeworks[®] lighting system, the new Polk Audio[®] IP-Based speaker, and *NetStreams*' new 50 watt per channel Intelligent Amplifier.

"We continue to advance the capabilities of the IP-Based *DigiLinX* entertainment system for the benefit of installers and their customers," said Herman Cardenas, founder and chief executive officer of *NetStreams*. "We take tremendous pride in our industry leadership and pace of innovation."

According to Cardenas, *NetStreams* is providing a new graphical interface for its *TouchLinX*[™] touch screen controller, or any control device connected to the *DigiLinX* network. This upgrade provides easy navigation through selection and control of audio sources, lighting scenes, heating and cooling options, and Panasonic[®] cameras. There also is a new 10-key screen for direct tuning of XM radio stations from the Polk Audio Xrt12 XM Tuner, as well as a DVD player screen for control of a DVD player connected to the system.

NetStreams also is providing new firmware for *ControLinX*[™] CL100, including drivers for Lutron HomeWorks Lighting Systems. This upgrade enables control of a HomeWorks lighting system through a *DigiLinX* user interface, including turning on/off up to 17 custom lighting scenes from *TouchLinX*, a wireless Web tablet, PDA or PC.

New firmware for the *SpeakerLinX*[™] SL250 50-watt x 2 Intelligent Amplifier now enables it as a choice in the drop down box. This upgrade allows an IP-based amplifier with more power for larger rooms, including 12 DSP presets that the customer can select from the new graphical interface.
